



ORLEANS/EAST JEFFERSON LEVEE DISTRICT POLICE



This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. 1st Week of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, April 15th – April 22, 2018.

04-15-2018 - Ofc. B. Vining responds to **#48 Finch Street** in response to a Suspicious Vehicle called in by a female resident. Ofc. Vining canvasses the area for a "Blue Armada" with a witness statement of two subjects inside. Ofc. Vining stays in the area to assist the female caller getting into her residence safely. Orleans Levee District Police and NOPD 3rd District are notified as well.

04-16-2018 – Ofc. A. Agee assists NOPD with (2) Calls for Service at **Robert E. Lee and Beauregard**. There were (2) Vehicular accidents at this location, one accident had a stated injury. Ofc. Agee assisted with traffic control and allowing Lake Vista residents to safely maneuver around the accident scenes into the Lake Vista Subdivision and surrounding areas.

Sgt. G. Duplessis, provides a requested escort for a resident at **#14 Wren Street**. Escort request came through the Orleans Levee District Main line and dispatched accordingly.

04-17-2018 – Sgt. G. Duplessis is flagged down by the resident at **#9 Wren Street**. The resident relays that her dog is lost and gives a physical description to the officer. Sgt. Duplessis canvasses the area during the entirety of his patrol hours. This information is passed on to other officers, both on the detail and on regular duty.

Sgt. M. Schindler assists a resident at **100 Oriole Street** walking the resident to her door and makes sure she is safely inside.

04-18-2018 – Capt. V. Yetta diligently assists at (4) locations within the Subdivision as follows:

- 1.) **101 S. Wren** – Observes open front door, finds resident inside and in no trouble.
- 2.) **88 N. Wren** – Observes open trunk on vehicle, alerts homeowner.
- 3.) **106 N. Lark** – Homeowner flags down this detail officer, Community Relations.
- 4.) **48 Finch** – Homeowner is escorted/assisted getting her groceries in her house.

04-19-2018 – Lt. T. Butler observes the interior dome light on a vehicle at **#33 Egret**. There is no sign of forced entry, tampering or foul play. He checks the license plate and notifies the owner.

Sgt. G. Duplessis assists a homeowner with a requested escort at **#14 Wren**.

04-22-2018 – Sgt. M. Schindler observes (2) open doors on vehicles at **68 Flamingo and 103 Egret**. Resident at 68 Flamingo was notified, no foul play. 103 Egret, Resident is notified and Sgt. Schindler learns the resident is unloading groceries, no further assistance requested.

04-23-2018 - Lt. T. Butler provides an escort to resident at #14 Wren Street.

04-25-2018 – Ofc. A. Agee responds to a dispatched call of a suspicious vehicle, male and female inside, at the intersection of Bluebird and R.E. Lee. Upon arrival, the vehicle is gone. This officer searches the surrounding areas and streets, but no vehicle matching the description is found.

04-26-2018 – Sgt. M. Schindler responds to citizen complaint of an abandoned vehicle near #9 Lark, White Buick Lesabre is observed unoccupied. Vehicle is checked, no listing of stolen, no forced entry, no damage advised.

04-26-2018 – Sgt. G. Duplessis provides an escort to resident at #48 Finch Street.

04-26-2018 – Sgt. G. Duplessis provides an escort to resident at #20 Lark Street.

04-26-2018 – Sgt. G. Duplessis observes an open door on a vehicle at #98 Thrasher. He contacts the resident who states they are unloading items.

04-27-2018 – Ofc. W. Zink observes the trunk on a personal vehicle open, at #98 Wren. Ofc. Zink makes contact with the resident, who thanks him. Her husband fell asleep and left the trunk open on their car. Vehicle is secured, no further issue.

04-28-2018 – Ofc. B. Vining makes traffic stop at Beauregard and Lark. Vehicle is stopped for no turn signaling. Ofc. Vining gives a verbal warning to resident of Lake Vista Community.

04-29-2018 – Ofc. W. Zink assists a motorist with changing a flat tire at Beauregard and R. E. Lee.

04-29-2018 – Ofc. W. Zink provides an escort to resident at #105 Lark Street.

04-29-2018 – Ofc. W. Zink hears Orleans Levee District Police and New Orleans Police searching for subjects involved in vehicle burglaries in Lake Terrace. He assists by searching the areas of Lake Vista for any possible suspects fleeing to the area. Orleans Levee District Ofc. B. Wilson, makes an apprehension of an African American male at Heron and R.E. Lee, who is positively identified as one of the suspects wanted in the burglaries. NOPD is advised that OLDP has one in custody and suspect is turned over to NOPD for charges and booking processes.
