



## **ORLEANS/EAST JEFFERSON LEVEE DISTRICT POLICE**



This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4th Weeks of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, May 1st – May 14, 2018.

**05-01-2018 #31 Lark 6:17 p.m.:** Sgt. M. Schindler responds to the location on a complaint call of a subject using “throwing knives” on the property. Resident/Owner was identified as the person of interest. Resident was interviewed on his private property as a welfare and safety check.

**05-02-2018 #48 Finch 11:10 p.m.:** Ofc. J. Martin was flagged down by the resident and asked for a follow up on the Blue Armada seen in the area in weeks past. Ofc. Martin advised the resident of the BOLO in effect on the information and the description given to the detail officers. Vehicle has not been observed back in the area since the original complaint.

**05-02-2018 Beauregard and Robert E. Lee 2:00 p.m.:** Anonymous 911 Call of a child locked in a vehicle. Sgt. M. Schindler responded to the area but was not flagged down and could not find anyone in harm’s way.

**05-03-2018 Robert E. Lee and Wisner 4:24 p.m.:** Ofc. Daniel Biggs responds to assist Orleans Levee District Maintenance Crews when two tractors collided at the intersection. No injuries reported.

**05-03-2018 #88 Egret 3:48 a.m.:** Ofc. J. Martin responds to a noise disturbance call of someone repeatedly knocking on the front door at location. No description given. Outer area of the home and surrounding areas patrolled, no suspicious persons on foot or vehicles found in the area.

**05-04-2018 #35 Dove 4:15 p.m.:** Ofc. A. Agee responds to an audible burglar alarm heard in the area. He identifies it coming from the house at #35 Dove. Ofc. Agee checks the perimeter and finds no signs of forced entry, tampering or damage. NOPD dispatch notified as well.

**05-04-2018 #105 Lark 11:15 p.m.:** Ofc. A. Agee assists an elderly female from her vehicle in to her home.

**05-05-2018 #2 Thrasher 2:46 p.m.:** Ofc. W. Zink responds to a Panic Alarm dispatched to this residence. Ofc. Zink meets an on-duty Orleans Levee District Police unit and they team up to search the property. Neighbors come out and speak to the officers and state that no one was believed to be home. They search the property perimeter and knock on all the doors. No physical entry or damage was observed, no foul play identified. NOPD dispatch notified as well.

**05-06-2018 #35 Dove 3:37 p.m.:** Ofc. W. Zink responds to a repeat audible alarm at this residence. Ofc. Zink does a perimeter check of the property and finds no forced entry or damage. NOPD dispatch is notified as well.

**05-06-2018 #105 Lark 11:56 p.m.:** Sgt. G. Duplessis assists resident with getting bags out of her car and escorts her into her home.

**05-07-2018 #61 Warbler 6:55 p.m.:** Ofc. W. Zink observes the trunk open on a vehicle at the residence. He speaks with the owners who state they were inside getting ready to pack their vehicle. No foul play involved.

**05-11-2018 #35 Dove 4:26 p.m.:** Sgt. M. Schindler responds to an audible repeat alarm at the residence. Sgt. Schindler checks the perimeter and finds no forced entry or damage to the location.

**05-11-2018 #6 Swan 2:35 a.m.:** Ofc. B. Vining meets with an on-duty Orleans Levee District Police Unit at this location for an ADT Alarm Set-Off. Officers team up and search the perimeter. No signs of forced entry, damage or foul play was observed. NOPD dispatch is advised as well.

**05-12-2018 #9 Ibis 2:44 p.m.:** Ofc. L. Gerhold responds to an ADT alarm. Ofc. Gerhold checks with the resident who verifies it was accidental in nature.

**05-13-2018 Robert E. Lee and Spanish Fort Blvd.1:00 a.m.:** Ofc. E. Leblanc was flagged down by resident outside their property stating they saw a red vehicle, suspicious in the area. Ofc. Leblanc states he patrols the surrounding streets and both directions of Robert E. Lee, but the described vehicle is not located.

Leblanc makes contact with the driver and passenger. He identifies both subjects by obtaining legal identification. Both subjects are checked showing no warrants or attachments on file for either subject. No foul play identified.

**05-14-2018 #20 Thrush 3:30 p.m.:** Walk-In complaint to the OLDP Police Dispatcher of a vehicle burglary at the location. LVCPD Detail Ofc. A. Agee meets OLDP Full time officer J. Holmes at the location. Owner of the vehicle says his car was unoccupied from 10:00 p.m. 05-13-2018 until 3:00 p.m. on 05-14-2018.
