This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 15 and 16 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, July 23rd – August 6th, 2018.

July 23, 2018 6304 Beauregard 6:04 p.m. – Ofc. B. Zink is dispatched via 911 call to dispatch to a general complaint in the grass area between Beauregard and the waterway canal, across from Lake Vista Subdivision. Caller refused to identify themselves. Caller complained that a wedding was in progress without proper permits. Ofc. Zink investigated the area and discovered there was no existing ordinance to prohibit the wedding in progress.

July 23, 2018 1171 R. E. Lee 10:17 p.m. – Sgt. G. Duplessis assists OLDP Police Units with a suspected stolen vehicle reported in the area. Description of the vehicle is given but units are unable to locate the car in the area. Information was that the vehicle was in motion, passing down R. E. Lee.

July 25, 2018 22 Swan 5:01 p.m. – Capt. V. Yetta responds to an audible burglary alarm at the location. Surrounding perimeter is checked, no damage or forced entry is observed, location secure.

July 26, 2018 Marconi and R. E. Lee 4:29 p.m. – Capt. V. Yetta is dispatched to the location concerning a vagrant panhandling at the location. Upon arrival, Capt. Yetta searches the area but no subjects are found.

July 26, 2018 Marconi and R.E. Lee 7:00 p.m. – Capt. Yetta assists NOPD/OLDP with a white Ford Pick Up truck refusing to stop. Vehicle was in pursuit by NOPD earlier from within the 3rd District. Capt. Yetta assists to the area of the Lake Vista Detail perimeter.

July 29, 2018 Lakeshore and Rail 8:15 p.m. – Ofc. S. Meunier responds to a call of a vehicle driving “reckless” in the area. Upon arrival, no vehicles committing traffic violations is observed.

July 30, 2018 Bluebird and R. E. Lee 8:27 p.m. – Capt. V. Yetta assists OLDP Police with a call of a suspicious person

July 31, 2018 105 Lark 8:04 p.m. – Ofc. M. Hoctel assists the resident with getting groceries into the house.

July 31, 2018 Rail and Lakeshore – 10:22 p.m. – Ofc. D. Biggs handles a call of juveniles making noise in the public parking lot. All subjects are cleared from the area.

August 3rd, 2018 Snipe at Marconi 8:43 hrs. – Ofc. B. Zink observes a suspicious vehicle driving slowly up and down the street. Driver is identified as a hired contractor looking for the correct address.

August 4th, 2018 Lakeshore and Rail 10:27 p.m. – Ofc. D. Biggs clears the public parking lot of subjects making audible noise with their cars.

August 5th, 2018 #45 Wren 3:40 and 4:29 a.m. – Lt. T. Butler responds to this location on (2) separate times for an ADT Alarm set off. Each time, there is no damage or signs of forced entry. Location is secure.

This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 17 and 18 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, August 6th – August 19th, 2018

August 7th, 2018 Beauregard @ R.E. Lee 9:12 p.m. – Ofc. Meunier responded to assist NOPD as a call came out for assistance, of shots fired on the east of R.E. Lee, past the Lake Vista Subdivision. Upon arrival with NOPD, there was no complainant on scene and no shots audibly heard.

August 8th, 2018 - Various Calls handled by Capt. V. Yetta/See Below:

#4 Thrasher 2:56 p.m. – Capt. Yetta responds to a Panic Alarm. Accidental with the owner.

Rail @ Lakeshore 7:42 p.m. – Capt. Yetta shuts down loud music emitting from vehicles in the area.

Beauregard @ Lakeshore 10:20 p.m. – Capt. Yetta assists OLDP with a traffic stop in the area.

August 13th, 2018 #54 Finch 3:05 a.m. – Ofc. D. Biggs observes an open slot to the front door of this residence being open, light emitting from inside the residence. Ofc. Biggs called for back-up in case foul play was in effect. Officers checked and cleared the residence with no sign of forced entry, no sign of ransacking, no signs of damage and no signs of theft. Residents were not home but location was secured. Official notification of officers being inside the residence was left for the residents. Residents were instructed to call OLDP dispatch upon their return as well.

August 16th, 2018 Lark @ Beauregard 9:15 p.m. – Ofc. D. Biggs observed a white male leave the residential side of Lake Vista and begin walking in the wooded area near the canal. Ofc. Biggs was then flagged down by a female resident who also saw this suspicious person. Ofc. Biggs made contact with the white male and identified him as resident out exercising who lived in the neighborhood.

August 18th, 2018 1033 R.E. Lee 2:23 p.m. – Ofc. B. Zink was dispatched to an ADT Alarm going off at the residence. Upon arrival, the house was listed for sale. Ofc. Zink called the realtor who came to the property, with a blood relative of the seller. Residence was checked, no sign of entry.

On the same date, Ofc. Zink responded to an audible alarm @ 1067 R.E. Lee. Ofc. Zink made contact with the resident, alarm set off was accidental.

August 18th, 2018 Egret @ R.E.Lee 1010 p.m. – Ofc. Hoctel responded to a dispatched call of a suspicious brown vehicle with an older, bearded, white male driver, seen in the area. Ofc. Hoctel responded to the area, searched, but the suspicious vehicle was not located.
