This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses Weeks 11-12 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, June 25 – July 8th , 2018.

June 26, 2018 Beauregard @ R. E. Lee 9:50 p.m – Ofc G. Faust receives a flagged down complaint of an unidentified white male laying in the middle of the street. It was later learned that this subject had fallen off his bike and was scared to move due to possible physical injuries. Ofc. Faust requested New Orleans Emergency Medical Services with EMS Unit #3231 responding to the scene. Subject was transported by request to the hospital by the injured citizen.

June 26, 2018 #14 Wren 12:02 a.m. – Sgt. G. Duplessis responded to an escort request for an elderly female from her vehicle to her front door.

June 26, 2018 #105 Lark 12:11 a.m. – Sgt, Duplessis responded to an escort request.

June 27, 2018 #48 Lark 10:10 p.m. – Capt. V. Yetta hears an audible burglar alarm going off at this location. He advises OLDP Dispatch and checks the residence. Capt. Yetta relays there is no sign of damage, no sign of forced entry and all areas are secure.

June 29, 2018 #89 Spanish Fort 5:00 p.m. – Ofc. A. Agee is dispatched to an alarm in progress call at this location. Upon arrival, he meets with the resident who states that the alarm system was being tested. No further enforcement required.

This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 13 and 14 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail 07/09 – 07/23, 2018.

July 09, 2018 – 1713 R.E. Lee - 5:13 p.m. Resv. Capt. V. Yetta assists OLDP Units 7707 and 7708 on a suspicious persons call. No further action was requested from the Lake Vista detail rank.

July 09, 2018 – 37 Spanish Fort – 6:00 p.m. – Resv. Capt. V. Yetta handles an ADT Burglary Alarm. Upon arrival, resident identifies it was an accidental set off.

July 09, 2018 – Lakeshore and Tern – 6:44 p.m. – Resv, Capt. V. Yetta stops a vehicle for speeding. Lake Vista resident is given a verbal warning.

July 09, 2018 – Beauregard and Lakeshore – 9:22 p.m – Resv, Capt. Yetta handles an anonymous complaint of loud music. He relays that he disperses several subjects by the use of audible police speaker system.

July 09, 2018 – 105 Lark St. – 11:01 p.m. – Ofc A. Agee provides a requested escort at this location.

July 09, 2018 - 14 Wren St. – 11:41 p.m. – Ofc. A. Agee provides a requested escort at location.

July 11, 2018 – 46 Wren St. – 9:13 p.m. – Ofc. B. Zink provides a requested escort at this location.

July 13, 2018 – 105 Lark St. – 1130 p.m. – Sgt. G. Duplessis provides a requested escort at this location.

July 17, 2018 – 14 Hawk St. – 8:13 p.m. – Ofc. M. Hoctel responds to the location to have the owner of the residence advise him that he and his son's cars were "ransacked through" the night before. Resident tells officer Hoctel that both of the cars were left "overnight" and "unlocked." Resident advises Ofc. Hoctel that a wallet and money were taken from his son's car. Ofc. Hoctel advised this resident that a formal police report was needed, but resident and son decline. The resident relayed that (3) white males were seen on his personal home video. Since formal police reports were declined, information was relayed to NOPD for follow-up.

July 18, 2018 – 2 Dove St. – 2:45 p.m. – Ofc. A. Agee is flagged down by a landscaper who reports that "people were seen in his work truck." Information is relayed on "Next Door" and through email. Police units are dispatched to the immediate area. Area was canvassed by OLDP to no avail.

July 18, 2018 – 81 Egret – 2:29 p.m – Ofc. A. Agee handles a dispatched call of a suspicious Hispanic male in a Silver Toyota Camry. Upon arrival at the location, subject is identified picking up his wife working at the residence.

July 19, 2018 – 25 Gull St. – 9:45 p.m. – Ofc. S. Meunier observes (2) packages delivered at this location. Stepped up patrol was issued by Ms. Asher at her property while she was out of town. Ofc. Meunier relocates the packages to the rear of the residence, out of the viewable area, in concern for Ms. Asher's property.

July 20, 2018 – 25 Swan St. – 3:12 a.m – Ofc. G. Gaust receives a call from the resident refusing to pay cab fare for a known female, who requested private transport to his residence. Female was a prior acquaintance and worker for this resident. Resident states this "female" in question was "let go" and now was trying to extort money from him. Ofc. Faust calls for back-up with an OLDP Supervisor responding. Although the nature of this call was both civil and criminal in aspect, when both parties were interviewed together, both parties declined to make a complaint.
