This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 9-10 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, June 11 –25, 2018.

**June 11, 2018 105 Lark St. 9:17 p.m.** – Ofc. A. Agee responded to this address for a resident requesting to speak to the police. Upon arrival, Ofc.
