November 26, 2018 #105 Lark St. 6:25 a.m. – Ofc. Meunier responded to a requested escort for this residence.

November 27, 2018 Marconi @ Snipe 2:21 p.m. – Ofc. Gerhold responded to an auto accident with air bags deployed. Ofc. Gerhold observed moderate to severe damage between a moving vehicle and a parked vehicle at this incident location. This officer's investigation revealed that the moving vehicle had mechanical problems prior to impact. Ofc. Gerhold officially handled this crash report and submitted information relative to the incident to N.O.P.D. 3rd District as well.
