



## **ORLEANS/EAST JEFFERSON LEVEE DISTRICT POLICE**



**This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 37 and 38 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, December 24, 2018 to January 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019.**

**December 25, 2018/#62 Snipe/2:20 p.m.**- Ofc. Gerhold responds to a dispatched call from NOPD of an ADT Alarm going off at the location. Upon arrival, the call for service is cancelled by the resident as accidental.

**December 26, 2018/#54 N. Wren/3:05 p.m.** – Capt. Eagan responds to direct call into OLDP Dispatch of a disturbance amongst neighbors at this location. Complainant states that the neighbor's dog was not leashed, charged and caused her to fall resulting in injury. Capt. Eagan does a formal report in relation to her police action taken.

**December 27, 2018/ #14 Wren/11:25 p.m.** – Ofc. White responds to a dispatched request for an escort at this residence.

**December 31, 2018/ Egret @ R.E. Lee/7:39 p.m.** – Capt. Yetta responds to a dispatched call of “fire and smoke” in the area of intersection. Dispatch advises that the complainant refuses to identify themselves. Capt. Yetta arrives on scene at the dispatched location, is not flagged down and cannot identify the complaint in question.

**December 31, 2018/#74 N. Wren/11:26 p.m.** – Ofc. White receives a complaint by the residents at #74 Wren that juveniles were lighting fireworks, at #84 Wren. Upon arrival, Ofc. White confirms that fireworks are in play at the complaint location. Ofc. White speaks to the juveniles and adults at the location and advises of the illegality of use.

**(NOTE:** This is New Year's Eve. Traditionally numerous police factions call the 911 System complaining of fireworks, usually refusing to provide identification, since fireworks are illegal in Orleans Parish.)

**January 2, 2019/#105 Lark St./6:15 p.m.** – Ofc. Zink responds to a dispatched request for an escort at this residence.

**January 6, 2019/#105 Lark St./6:38 p.m.** - Ofc. Zink responds to a dispatched request for an escort at this residence.

**This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 39 and 40 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, January 7th – January 20th , 2018.**

**January 7<sup>th</sup>, 2019/Lakeshore @ Shelter #2/1157 p.m.** – Officer G. Faust intercepts a dispatched 911 call of Runaway w/ Possible Kidnapping involved on Lakeshore Drive. Ofc. Faust enters the area and is flagged down by the complainant/mother of the runaway juvenile. The mother states she observes her daughter with (4) unknown males in a vehicle on Lakeshore Drive. Ofc. Faust and back-up units surround the suspect vehicle and identify the runaway in question. None of the males have criminal backgrounds. Runaway states she voluntarily was with these subjects and made no statement she was being held against her will. NOPD Detectives were called out to the scene. Final Disposition handled by NOPD.

**January 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019/#14 Hawk St./10:55 p.m.** – Sgt. G. Duplessis was flagged down by the residential owner that an unknown black male was seen in the area “running between cars and driveways.” Sgt. Duplessis puts out the description to OLDP and NOPD Dispatch. As he and other units canvass the area, no suspicious person can be located. (The homeowner at this location was requested to review security camera footage and contact either police department to initiate a follow up investigation.)

**January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019/Lakeshore @ Marconi/7:25 p.m.** – Ofc. A. Zink sets up traffic control for a Lake Vista resident with a broken down vehicle. Ofc. Zink stays on scene until a private tow truck arrives and the citizen is safe.

**January 11<sup>th</sup>, 2019/6521 Spanish Fort/2:06 a.m.** – Ofc. M. White observes a Silver Ford F150 circling the front to back areas of the Community Center. Ofc. White stops the vehicle in question, but is able to identify the driver as an OLDP Reserve Officer.

**January 14<sup>th</sup>/# 14 Wren/11:40 p.m.** – Ofc. M. White receives a dispatched request to provide a police escort for this resident.

**January 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019/ #8 Ibis/10:10 p.m.** – Ofc. A. Zink receives a 911 call of a Burglary in Progress. Upon arrival at the location, Ofc. Zink identifies contractors with keys to the property, working late.

**January 18<sup>th</sup>, 2019/ #50 Wren/5:09 p.m.** – A Medical/Welfare check is requested for the owner of this residence. Ofc. A. Zink makes contact with the owner. The owner identifies no medical emergency.

**January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2019/Marconi @ R.E.Lee/11:08 p.m.** – 911 call of a Suspicious Vehicle in the area. Only description given was a “truck with large shiny rims” Ofc. M. White canvassed the area to no avail. Complainant refused to provide identification or what location they were calling from.
