This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 51 and 52 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, April 1st – April 14th , 2019.

April 1st, 2019/#14 Wren/ 11:37 p.m - Ofc. Faust responds to a dispatched request for a residential escort at this location.

April 3rd, 2019/#32 Spanish Fort/10:32 p.m. - Ofc. Zink is flagged down regarding possible private owner/vehicle damage. The resident explains to Ofc. Zink that her car door looks ajar, seems open, but is actually locked. Ofc. Zink converses with the resident and inspects her vehicle. Ofc. Zink does not find forced entry but does find that there is a damage and mechanical issues with the vehicle door in question.

April 4th, 2019/ Length of Gull Street/ 2:07 p.m - An alert email from the residents of the LVCPD is identified concerning suspicious persons "lifting on car door handles." Capt. Yetta was on scene in (4) minutes, working the Lake Vista Detail. Capt. Yetta accessed camera systems and identified a suspect vehicle immediately. Pictures were sent out to both Levee District Police Districts and sent to the LVCPD email thread. The surrounding areas were searched by OLDP and NOPD but no apprehensions were made.

April 5th, 2019/#25 Thrasher/2:32 p.m. - Capt. Yetta observes a suspicious Hispanic male in the area. Upon contact, he learns that this male is under private contract by a resident to cut and trim trees. No further action is taken.

April 8th, 2019/#84 Wren/9:00 p.m. - Ofc. Zink assists OLDP Unit #7706 with a Suspicious Persons call. No other report information at this time.

April 11, 2019/#1 Swan/10:12 p.m. - Ofc. Zink responds to a dispatched request for a residential escort at this location.

April 15th, 2019/# 14 Wren/12:06 a.m. – Ofc. Faust receives a dispatched request and provides a residential escort at this residence.

April 20, 2019/Community Center/9:01 p.m – Capt. Yetta responds to the Lake Vista Community Center in report of smoke or fire. Upon contact with New Orleans Fire Department, this was a small electrical outlet, overloaded, turned off by the responding fire personnel.

April 23, 2019/#31 Stilt/6:30 p.m. – Capt. Yetta is flagged down by residents at this address. Residents relay they think that their personal vehicle is “rummaged” through, but had no forced entry. Residents did not request a police report. Capt. Yetta notifies OLDP Dispatch and the on-duty rank, who in turn notify NOPD.

April 24, 2019/#55 Flamingo/9:10 p.m. – Ofc. Zink observes the garage door of an elderly resident open at this residence location. Ofc. Zink makes a courtesy contact and the resident secures the property.

April 24th, 2019/#3 Heron/8:57 p.m. – Ofc. Zink observes the trunk of a vehicle open at this residence. Ofc. Zink makes contact with the resident who states he was getting his grandchildren out and forgot to close the trunk. Resident secures the vehicle.
