This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks and of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, June 24th – July 21, 2019.

This is a (4) Week combined report due to the amended police security detail coverage that included Tropical Storm Barry:

June 24th, 2019/#19 Kildeer/7:28 p.m – Ofc. Gerhold witnesses a vehicular accident between the residents at #19 and #20 Kildeer. Ofc. Gerhold identifies the at-fault party, issues (3) moving citation violations and handles the police report accordingly.

June 24th, 2019/#14 Wren St./11:49 p.m. – Ofc. Faust responds to a request for a residential escort at this location.

June 28th, 2019/Marconi @ Lakeshore/5:50 p.m. – Capt. Yetta assists all patrol units from OLDP HQ in blocking the entry roadways to Lakeshore Drive. Imminent winds and expected flooding from the upcoming storm is in process. These efforts were to make sure Lake Vista residents did not attempted to enter street flooding areas.

July 2nd, 2019/#14 Wren/12:14 a.m. – Ofc. White responds to a request for a residential escort at this location.

July 4th, 2019/6510 Spanish Fort/3:04 p.m. – Capt. Yetta responds to a fire alarm at this location. This is a repeat issue, faulty alarm perceived.

July 7th, 2019/107 Lark St./10:48 p.m. – Ofc. White responded to call that the resident believed that a suspicious person was in the concrete power house station behind the residence. Ofc. White checked the concrete structure, it was not open and secured from the outside. No police action warranted.

July 9th, 2019/#14 Wren/12:08 a.m. – Ofc. Faust responds to a request for a residential escort at this location.

July 15th, 2019/Rail @ Lakeshore/11:13 p.m. – Ofc. White receives a dispatched call of loud music coming from vehicles in the area. Ofc. White disperses a crowd of teenagers in the adjacent parking lot near the levee.

July, 17th, 2019/Beauregard @ Lakeshore/4:50 a.m. – Ofc. White assisted a motorist with a flat tire.

July 20th, 2019/#25 Lark/2:20 p.m. - Capt. Yetta responds to resident who states that she is receiving harassing and explicit text messages. Capt. Yetta ascertains that these are internet advertisements and do not fit the criteria of a police response. Resident is advised how to stop such incoming information.

July 22, 2019/#7 Dove/12:16 a.m. – Ofc White assists OLDP Police unit #7713 responding to an alarm call. No sign of forced entry, not sign of vandalism, no response at the door.
