



## **ORLEANS/EAST JEFFERSON LEVEE DISTRICT POLICE**



**This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 59 and 60 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, May 27th – June 9th, 2019.**

**May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2019/Lakeshore@Rail/11:10 p.m.** – Ofc. Faust receives a dispatched call of crowd disturbance, both in motion and standing, on Lakeshore Drive and the adjacent parking lot. Ofc. Faust requests back-up with OLDP responding. The crowd is dispersed for noise violations.

**May 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019/1700 Lakeshore/10:01 p.m.** – Ofc. White receives a dispatched call of a number of reckless drivers identified from the 1300 block to the 1700 block of Lakeshore Drive. Ofc. White responds to the area, but does not find any violations as dispatched.

**June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019/#22 Swallow/6:17 p.m.** – Ofc. Zink is flagged down by the resident at this location stating that they will be out of town and requested patrols were asked for of the LVCPD Patrol Unit.

**June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2019/North Rail/8:36 p.m.** – Residential complainant advises that an unknown African American male was seen going through garbage placed on the street. Ofc. Zink found the subject traveling in a vehicle on Heron Street. Ofc. Zink does identify that in the rear of this truck is discarded junk and scrap metal. Ofc. Zink re-contacts the complainant who advises that pictures of the truck and the subject were taken and will be forwarded to local police agencies for suspicious person information. Ofc. Zink does not have a further complaint nor does he identify any criminal acts by this subject.

**Note:** Relative to this issue stated above, I contacted NOPD 3<sup>rd</sup> District, Quality of Life, and spoke to Sgt. Hogan. Upon inquiring to the legality of garbage and privacy rights, once discarded items are placed on or past the sidewalk, the expectation of privacy and ownership is no longer in effect. The area considered the curtilage is always in legal dispute, but must be understood. The actions of anyone who does not reside in the area, of course, substantiates the reason to call the police, as suspicious activity.
