This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. Weeks 79 and 80 of the Lake Vista Crime Prevention Detail, October 14th – 27th, 2019.

October 14, 2019/#14 Wren/11:38 p.m. – Ofc. Faust receives a dispatched call to assist with an escort at this residential location.

October 15, 2019/#22 Flamingo/4:21 p.m – Ofc. Zink responded to a 911 Call of juveniles driving a ‘go kart’ up and down the street. Upon arrival, Ofc. Zink did come into contact with a golf cart, manned by parents and juveniles. Instruction was given to the illegality of golf and/or go karts on municipal streets.

October 15, 2019/1121 R. E. Lee/2:14 a.m. – Ofc. Faust observed a Black Chevy Impala, running, with the windows down, no driver inside, in the driveway of the residence. Ofc. Faust investigates and is approached by a white female from the residence who stated she started her car and left it alone to get the heat out before running the air condition. White, by scene investigation, identifies this group and this vehicle as possible suspects, although he did not observe the actual complaint in progress. Ofc. White field interviews all (6) subjects and checks them for active warrants and attachments. All subjects were directed out of the area.
