This is a recap of the Police Productivity, Proactive and Reactive call responses. This is a COMBINED Report from September 16th, 2019 to October 13th, 2019.

September 16, 2019/# 14 Wren/11:44 p.m. – Ofc. Faust responds to a dispatched call for a residential escort at this location.

September 19, 2019/Rail @ Lakeshore/10:06 p.m. – Ofc. White receives multiple calls from dispatch about Loud Noise coming from the parking lot, near the Levee. As Ofc. White arrives near the location of complaint, he activates his police unit light bar and P.A. System, and disperses the parked cars emitting the loud music.

September 23, 2019/#14 Wren/11:48 p.m. – Ofc. White responds to a dispatched call for a residential escort at this location.

September 27, 2019/# 50 Finch/3:15 p.m. – Capt. Yetta is requested to make a welfare check at this location. A 911 call came into OLDP Dispatch stating that there was a white female on the premises, illegally trespassing. Upon arrival, Capt. Yetta identifies the female on scene and she proves that she lives there. Capt. Yetta learns this is an ongoing domestic issue and that male and female parties are involved, in an ongoing civil dispute.

September 30, 2019/#14 Wren/11:44 p.m. - Ofc. Faust responds to a dispatched call for a residential escort at this location.

October 7, 2019/#82 Dove/2:05 p.m. – Capt. Yetta responded to an ADT Burglar Alarm at this residence. Capt. Yetta checked the perimeter of the location finding no forced entry and no criminal damage. OLDP dispatch was notified.

October 7, 2019/# 32 Crane/8:41 p.m. – Capt. Yetta identifies a vehicle with the trunk open in the driveway of this residence. Capt. Yetta makes contact with the homeowner and finds there is no criminal damage or entry. Resident was aware it was open.

October 8, 2019/#14 Wren/12:36 a.m. – Ofc. White responds to a dispatched call for a residential escort at this location.

October 9, 2019/R.E. Lee @ Spanish Fort – Capt. Yetta is flagged down by a resident stating that there was a vehicular accident in progress at the above location. Upon arrival, Capt. Yetta identifies that this is Hit and Run with a bicyclist involved. Capt. Yetta contacted OLDP Dispatch who notified EMS. The cyclist refused medical treatment. OLDP Unit 7708 handled the incident report.

October 9, 2019 /Community Center Area/7:50 p.m. – Capt. Yetta is advised of a suspicious truck, A black Ford F150, possibly (2) African American males inside, canvassing the area. Capt. Yetta reports to the area but no such vehicle is identified.

October 12, 2019/6900 Spanish Fort/3:25 p.m. – Capt. Yetta is dispatched to Fire Alarm at the Community Center. Upon arrival, there is no sign of smoke or danger presented. Capt. Yetta checks the perimeter of the property and does not find any sign of an emergency.

October 12, #27 Finch/9:45 p.m. – Capt. Yetta receives a dispatched 911 call from OLDP Dispatch, complainant refused, of a large group of juveniles congregating in front this house. Upon arrival there is a party in progress. Capt. Yetta spoke to the home owner who stated, yes he was throwing a teen party for a family member, but certain individuals who did not have invitations or were trying to crash the party, were not allowed to come into his property. The commotion was that parents and other families were contacted to come and get there teenage children who were not allowed to come to the party.
